- 1. Did the novel accurately portray the complexities of the parent-child dynamic, even in cases of emotional and psychological abuse? Why or why not?
- 2. Did you feel that Nina was an unreliable narrator at any point in the story? Why or why not?
- 3. Nina referred to Phillip as a psychopath. Was that label justified?
- 4. What do you think drove Phillip's actions?
- 5. Cassie reacted badly to Nina's confession. Why do you think she did?
- 6. What were your thoughts on the trial? Is a 'Conspiracy of Silence' typical in these types of cases?
- 7. *Mommy did the right thing. Now you'll never have to meet the monster.* How did you view the ending? Were Nina's actions diabolical or long overdue justice?
- 8. What do you think the future holds for Mark and Nina as a couple?
